When: Friday, April 12, 9am-12pm (or until shred truck is full)

Where: Medal of Honor Park - 1711 Hillcrest Rd

What: Free document shredding and information available for protecting your identity.

Reminder: Please bring documents in boxes only (no plastic boxes or plastic garbage bags), no heavy binder clips, two boxes per vehicle, & no more than 50 lbs.

Come early, because once the shred truck fills, shredding will end.

Dormant Account Notice & Reminder

As a reminder, please make an annual transaction on your account to avoid Dormant Account status and possible fee.

If your Share or Share Draft account has no transactions, other than the posting of dividends or fees, for a period of one year or more, your account may classify as a Dormant Account and may be subject to a monthly fee per dormant share or share draft account. Minor accounts (under 19 years of age in AL), and accounts with an active loan, mortgage, credit card, or share and share draft accounts with a balance of \$1,000 or more are not subject to a Dormant Account service charge.

April Fraud Tips

As AI scams are on the rise, here are some tips to help protect yourself and loved ones from AI voice-cloning scams:

- 1. Fact-check with the caller and verify who they are. Try obtaining their phone number and other information to report as fraud if necessary.
- 2. Hang up! If you pick up a call from an unknown number and it sounds like a panicking family member, end the call; then call or

- text that person with the number YOU have for them.
- 3. If it's your lawyer, doctor, or a financial professional, don't immediately believe their claims or answer their questions. Instead, call the institution or professional back on the phone number listed on their website or the number you have for them.
- 4. Don't talk much with these scammers. If they have a long clip of your voice, they may try to clone your voice as well.
- 5. To avoid family scams, have an unusual family keyword to use in conversation that only the family would understand.

Please Note: NHCU has a system that monitors members' accounts for possible fraud. You may be contacted if fraud is suspected, but NHCU will never ask for personal information such as online credentials, your entire card number, account number, or social security number via email, voice, or text messaging.
